## SUMMER CAMP : TR-05 THE CRADLE OF CIVILISATIONS

Participants	: 6 boys and 6 girls, non-smoking, one from each country.
Age	: 16 - 21
Camp Location	: Istanbul
Language	: English
Programme	: Various programs in Istanbul to introduce this "Queen of the Cities" as it was once called in the Middle Ages. In 3 days of the program, we will visit historical sites on the Istanbul peninsula. In the remaining days, we will swim in the sea, take a boat tour, wander around the touristic areas of the city and the Bosphorus and have free time. The club meeting will be held on Thursday evening during the week we plan the trip. Our guests and their host families will also attend this meeting. The guest students will make a presentation introducing their own countries. After the meeting, the guest students will be given a certificate and a club flag for their participation in the camp.
Clothing	: Comfortable clothing suitable for warm weather. Hat, sunglasses and swimming clothes should not be forgotten.
Arrival/Departure	: Participants will be met at Istanbul International Airport or Sabiha Gökçen International Airport on Saturday, June 28 <sup>th</sup> (daytime) and the departures will be on Tuesday July 8 <sup>th</sup> from Istanbul International Airport or Sabiha Gökçen International Airport.
Official Papers	: Tourist visa to Turkey (where necessary)
Cost	: Participation fee is €450. Money transfer should be completed before one month ETA to Istanbul. IBAN number will be informing.
Insurance	: Participants should be insured against illness, accident and third party liability with out any exceptions. Insurance policies should be sent to us before one month ETA to Istanbul.
Information	: A detailed program will be given to the participants on arrival. Students are required to prepare a presentation of maximum 3 minutes introducing their hometown/country and share it with us approximately 1 month before attending the camp.
